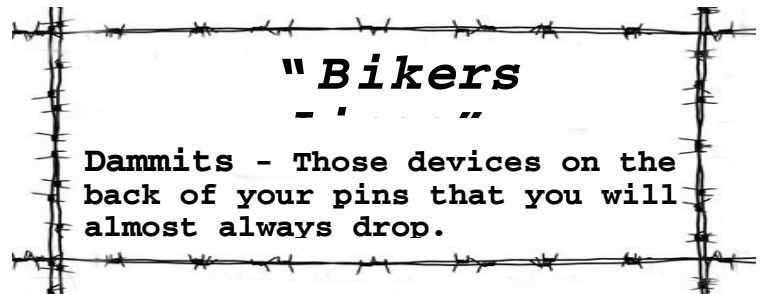

## RIDE SAFE

So, I was riding down the road the other day and I notice a slight vibration coming from the front tire. At the next stop I checked it and everything looked okay. It had plenty of tread and no obvious cuts or damage. Thinking that I had just lost a wheel weight and the wheel just needed to be balanced I continued on my merry way. I did notice that when I made a left turn at speed the vibration got more pronounced but I thought that it might be the side that the weight needed to be placed on. Besides, it was just a little vibration.

Yesterday while getting everything ready for the San Diego run, I decided to get the wheel balanced. I took my ride up to Bikers Bay on Bell Rd. We put it up on the lift and began to remove the front wheel and tire. The Harley Tech. asked what was going on with the bike. I told him about the vibration and, as an after thought, I mentioned the thing about the vibration getting more pronounced while turning left. He gave me a funny look and then ran his hand over the tire a couple of times. He asked me to do the same thing and what did I find...large knots or bumps on the tire. While the tread looked fine the tire was breaking down. The Tech. said that it could have blown at any time. I had just been riding at 65 to 70 mph on the 101 on the way over to have it looked at.

So, the short story is, pay attention to what your bike is telling you. If you notice something is just not right, check it out as soon as possible. Then have a Tech check it out just to make sure that everything is OK.
